# MOUNT CLEAR HOME WINS HIA WESTERN VICTORIA HOME OF THE YEAR







Ballarat Construction Management has been awarded the HIA Western Victoria Regional Home of the Year for its luxurious Mount Clear family home.

The winner was announced tonight in Fyansford, Geelong at the HIA Western Victoria Regional Housing Awards before a crowd of local industry leaders and peers from across the region.

Ballarat Construction Management has created a showpiece of exceptional design, cutting edge finishes and beautiful components, in this spectacular family home nestled against the tranquil surroundings of the Canadian Creek.

'This cleverly designed home integrates the surrounding bushland whilst maintaining a contemporary design', the judges noted. The project is complemented by 'the highest standard of workmanship that truly makes this a unique and striking home.'

This luxurious family home comprises four bedrooms, a study, two living zones, two bathrooms, powder room, gallery style entry, retreat style master bedroom, sauna, spa, alfresco, 110,000 litre water tank and garaging for three vehicles, all on a single level.

A stunning feature is the 'wine barrel' door into the climate controlled cellar, while galvanised iron wire bottle racks create a sense of sophistication and storage for over 600 bottles.

The natural elements of spotted gum timber flooring and timber paneling work effortlessly against the stark contrast of stone bench tops, exposed steel beams, expansive double glazed windows and polished concrete.

Step outside and be met by the use of classic cedar cladding, face brickwork and render mixed with modern building mediums, architectural fencing and Colorbond roofing on various pitches. A curved feature fixed panel wall allows for uninterrupted views of the surrounding landscape and manicured lawns.

HIA Victorian Executive Director Gil King congratulated the winners. "What a wonderful result for the Mount Clear community", Mr King said. 'This 9 month project is a credit to the working relationship established between the builder, client and architect.'



'HIA is delighted with the exceptional quality of entries this year. All winners and finalists should be proud to have reached the pinnacle of building standards demonstrated in these quality homes,' he said.

'It can be very easy to be distracted by the negatives in the current market, however the Ballarat region has only seen a 2.2% decrease in the total number of new home starts for the 12 months to May 2013, from the same period to May 2012. This is comparable to the number of new home starts from May 2011.' said Mr. King.

Ballarat Construction Management will go on to compete against other Custom Built Homes from around the state at the 2013 HIA CSR Victoria Housing and Kitchen & Bathroom Awards, to be held in November at Crown Towers in Melbourne.

The HIA Victorian judging panel is comprised of 37 independent individuals who have a range of experience and expertise within the Victorian residential construction industry. The panel includes builders, architects and designers, building surveyors, planners and manufacturers / suppliers. HIA judges operate independently from HIA and its Committees.

Projects are judged on a range of specific criterion including:

- Quality of workmanship
- Design Effectiveness
- Visual Appeal
- Innovation
- Environmental Sustainability, and
- Market Relevance

Regional awards are held in South East Victoria, North East Victoria, North West Victoria and Western Victoria each year. All Regional Home of the Year winners become automatic finalists in their respective categories in the HIA-CSR Victorian Housing and Kitchen & Bathroom Awards to be held in November at Crown Towers, Melbourne.

HIA conducts a Housing and Kitchen & Bathroom Awards program in each state across Australia with overall winners advancing to the Australian Housing Awards in May 2014.
